Course Descriptions

Post-Exilic Prophets (OT 139): This course will be a study of the message of Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi. Emphasis will be given to both the prophets' historical setting and their contribution to biblical theology.

Revelation (NT 222): This course will be a study of Revelation, Attention is given to the historical background, interpretation, and theology of the epistle.

Bible Interpretation (ST 304): This course is a systematic study of various principles for interpreting correctly the literature of the Bible.

Galatians (NT 211): This class is designed to help understand the basic content and teaching of the book of Galatians. Attention will be given to the historical background of the letter, the development of Paul's argument, and the resultant implications concerning freedom from the Law of Moses.
