Course Descriptions

Haggai/Malachi (OT137): This course will be a study of the message of Haggai and Malachi. Emphasis will be given to both the prophets' historical setting and their contribution to biblical theology.

Key Figures in Church History (CH410): This course is a study of key figures who were used by God to guide and strengthen the church throughout the past 2,000 years of church history.

Matthew (NT203): This course is an exposition of Matthew's gospel, focusing on the purpose and argument of the book. Special attention will be given to how Matthew arranges specific accounts of Jesus to make one unique story.

Church Denominations (CH408): This course will study the development of denominations after the Protestant Reformation. Focus will be given to the history and primary principles behind prominent denominations.
