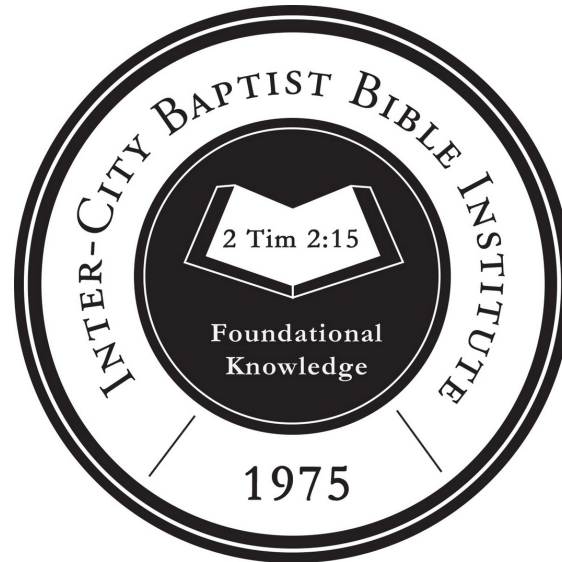


What is the Inter-City Baptist Bible Institute?

Course Descriptions

Colossians and Philemon (NT214): This course is designed for an in-depth study of Colossians and Philemon. After a brief survey of the historical background, the focus will be on identifying Paul's theme and tracing its development.

Luke Chapters 1-12 (NT230): This course is designed for an in-depth study of the first half of Luke's gospel.

I Thessalonians (NT215): This course will consider Paul's ministry to the church at Thessalonica, his continued desire to see them grow in Christlikeness, the nature of their exemplary testimony, and his instructions to them about various church life matters.

Scripture and God (ST301): This course is a systemic study of the introduction to Bible Doctrine, the inspiration of the Scriptures and their consequent inerrancy and infallibility, and the Doctrine of God.
