Course Descriptions

James (NT218): An exposition of the book of James, focusing on the dominant themes of the epistle, the flow of the author's argument, and the theological and exegetical difficulties presented in the text.

How To Study the Bible (PT309): This course will develop the skills needed to read and understand God's word. The textbook, *Grasping God's Word*, will guide the student through a reading strategy that makes Bible study profitable.

Galatians (NT211): This class is designed to help understand the basic content and teaching of the book of Galatians. Attention will be given to the historical background of the letter, the development of Paul's argument, and the resultant implications concerning freedom from the Law of Moses.

Foundations of Parenting (PT511): This course is a study of the foundational principles that are essential to training children in godliness, regardless of their age. It will also provide practical help for navigating the challenges of each stage in child development.
