Dr. Mark Snoeberger: Dr. Snoeberger has earned his B.A., M.Div., Th.M., and Ph.D. He became a part-time faculty member at Detroit Baptist Theological Seminary in 1999 and a full-time member in 2008 teaching Systematic Theology.

He serves as the Chairman of the Practical Theology Department and teaches the core pastoral theology courses in the M.Div. program.

Course Descriptions

Doctrine of the Holy Spirit (ST303): This course is a systematic study of the person and work of the Holy Spirit.

Handling Conflict Biblically (PT530): A broken world is full of problems that can turn into conflicts, whether at home or in the church. This class will look at what the Bible says about dealing with conflict in ways that are helpful and God-honoring (vs. man-centered and ultimately unhelpful).

Caring for One Another (PT531): This class provides biblical training and resources for believers to care for one another within the context of the local church. It provides practical ways in which believers can participate in the care of other members who are dealing with sin or suffering. It also equips believers to identify and move toward others with intentional care.

1 Peter (NT219): The Apostle Peter's first letter provides timely guidance for believers trying to honor God while living in a world which opposes Him and them. This course will be an exposition of the theme and content of 1 Peter.
