6/1-7, Psalm 19:7-8

The law of the LORD is perfect, restoring the soul; The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. The precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes.

6/8-14, Psalm 19:9-11

The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever; The judgments of the LORD are true; they are righteous altogether. They are more desirable than gold, yes, than much fine gold; Sweeter also than honey and the drippings of the honeycomb. Moreover, by them Your servant is warned; In keeping them there is great reward.

6/15-21, John 6:35

Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; he who comes to Me will not hunger, and he who believes in Me will never thirst."

6/22-28, Galatians 6:9-10

Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary. So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith.

6/29-7/5, Psalm 34:1-3

I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.
My soul will make its boast in the LORD; The humble will hear it and rejoice. O magnify the LORD with me, And let us exalt His name together.

7/6-12, Psalm 34:4-5

I sought the LORD, and He answered me, And delivered me from all my fears. They looked to Him and were radiant, And their faces will never be ashamed.

7/13-19, Psalm 34:6-8

This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him And saved him out of all his troubles. The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, And rescues them. **O taste and see that the LORD is good; How blessed is the man who takes refuge in Him!**

7/20-26, Psalm 34:9-11

O fear the LORD, you His saints; For to those who fear Him there is no want. **The young lions do lack and suffer hunger; But they who seek the LORD shall not be in want of any good thing. Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the LORD.**

7/27-8/2, Psalm 34:12-14

Who is the man who desires life And loves length of days that he may see good? **Keep your tongue from evil And your lips from speaking deceit. Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it.**

8/3-9, Psalm 34:15-16

The eyes of the LORD are toward the righteous And His ears are open to their cry. The face of the LORD is against evildoers, To cut off the memory of them from the earth.

8/10-16, Psalm 34:17-18

The righteous cry, and the LORD hears And delivers them out of all their troubles. The LORD is near to the brokenhearted And saves those who are crushed in spirit.

8/17-23, Psalm 34:19-22

Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the LORD delivers him out of them all. He keeps all his bones, Not one of them is broken. Evil shall slay the wicked, And those who hate the righteous will be condemned. The LORD redeems the soul of His servants, And none of those who take refuge in Him will be condemned.

8/24-30, Colossians 4:6

Let your speech always be with grace, as though seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person.

8/31-9/6, John 8:31-32

So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, **"If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."**

9/7-13, John 10:10

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly."

9/14-20, Jeremiah 32:40

I will make an everlasting covenant with them that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; and I will put the fear of Me in their hearts so that they will not turn away from Me.

9/21-27, Psalm 73:25-26

Whom have I in heaven but You? And besides You, I desire nothing on earth.

My flesh and my heart may fail, But God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

9/28-10/4, Proverbs 4:23-24

Watch over your heart with all diligence, For from it flow the springs of life.

Put away from you a deceitful mouth And put devious speech far from you.

10/5-11, Proverbs 4:25-27

Let your eyes look directly ahead And let your gaze be fixed straight in front of you. **Watch the path of your feet And all your ways will be established. Do not turn to the right nor to the left; Turn your foot from evil.**

10/12-18, James 1:19-20

This you know, my beloved brethren. But everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak and slow to anger; for the anger of man does not achieve the righteousness of God.

10/19-25, 2 Corinthians 8:9

For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, **that though He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor, so that you through His poverty might become rich.**

10/26-11/1, Psalm 77:13-14

Your way, O God, is holy; What god is great like our God? **You are the God who works wonders; You have made known Your strength among the peoples.**

11/2-8, Psalm 118:5-8

From my distress I called upon the LORD; The LORD answered me and set me in a large place. The LORD is for me; I will not fear; What can man do to me? The LORD is for me among those who help me; Therefore I will look with satisfaction on those who hate me. It is better to take refuge in the LORD Than to trust in man.

11/9-15, 1 Timothy 6:6-7

But godliness actually is a means of great gain when accompanied by contentment. **For we have brought nothing into the world, so we cannot take anything out of it either.**

11/16-22, Psalm 79:9

Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of Your name; And deliver us and forgive our sins for Your name's sake.

11/23-29, Psalm 84:10-11

For a day in Your courts is better than a thousand outside. I would rather stand at the threshold of the house of my God Than dwell in the tents of wickedness. **For the LORD God is a sun and shield; The LORD gives grace and glory; No good thing does He withhold from those who walk uprightly.**

11/30-12/6, 1 John 4:4

You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.

12/7-13, 1 Corinthians 15:51-52

Behold, I tell you a mystery; we will not all sleep, but we will all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.

12/14-20, Revelation 21:3

And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, **"Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them."**

12/21-27, Revelation 21:4

"And He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away."

12/28-1/3, Revelation 21:5-6

And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." And He said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true." **Then He said to me, "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give to the one who thirsts from the spring of the water of life without cost."**

1/4-10, Deuteronomy 7:9

Know therefore that the LORD your God, **He is God, the faithful God, who keeps His covenant and His lovingkindness to a thousandth generation with those who love Him and keep His commandments.**

1/11-17, Deuteronomy 10:12-13

Now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require from you, **but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways and love Him, and to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, and to keep the LORD'S commandments and His statutes** which I am commanding you today for your good?

1/18-24, John 1:12-13

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

1/25-31, Romans 11:33-36

Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways! For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has become his counselor? Or who has first given to him that it might be paid back to him again? For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him be the glory forever. Amen.

2/1-7, Romans 12:1-2

Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

2/8-14, Psalm 56:3-4

When I am afraid, I will put my trust in You. In God, whose word I praise, In God I have put my trust; I shall not be afraid. What can mere man do to me?

2/15-21, Psalm 62:5-7

My soul, wait in silence for God only, For my hope is from Him. He only is my rock and my salvation, My stronghold; I shall not be shaken. On God my salvation and my glory rest; The rock of my strength, my refuge is in God.

2/22-28, Romans 8:1

Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

3/1-7, 1 John 2:15-17

Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. **For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world.** The world is passing away, and also its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.

3/8-14, Philippians 2:5-7

Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, **although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men.**

3/15-21, Philippians 2:8-9

Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name.

3/22-28, Philippians 2:10-11

So that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

3/29-4/4, Philippians 2:12-13

So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, **work out your salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.**

4/5-11, James 1:2-3

Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance.

4/12-18, James 1:4-5

And let endurance have its perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing. **But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him.**

4/19-25, Psalm 1:1-2

How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, **Nor stand in the path of sinners, Nor sit in the seat of scoffers! But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night.**

4/26-5/2, Psalm 1:3-4

He will be like a tree firmly planted by streams of water, Which yields its fruit in its season And its leaf does not wither; And in whatever he does, he prospers. The wicked are not so, But they are like chaff which the wind drives away.

5/3-9, Psalm 1:5-6

Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, Nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous. For the LORD knows the way of the righteous, But the way of the wicked will perish.

5/10-16, Colossians 3:1-3

Therefore if you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth. For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God.

5/17-23, Ephesians 4:26

Be angry, and yet do not sin, do not let the sun go down on your anger.

5/24-30, Isaiah 40:28-29

Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth does not become weary or tired. His understanding is inscrutable. He gives strength to the weary, And to him who lacks might He increases power.

5/31-6/6, Isaiah 40:30-31

Though youths grow weary and tired, And vigorous young men stumble badly, **Yet those who wait for the LORD Will gain new strength; They will mount up with wings like eagles, They will run and not get tired, They will walk and not become weary.**
