Course Descriptions

A Believer's Guide to Natural Law (PT532): Whether on the right or the left, it's clear that we live in a morally bankrupt culture. But God did not create a world of moral chaos. Though fallen, the world still reflects his purpose and order—and that's what we mean by natural law. It's the moral standard God has embedded in creation—what He expects of all people, everywhere. In this class, we'll explore the history of natural law, its biblical foundations, and how believers can use it to make compelling, commonsense arguments for truth, justice, and human dignity.

Ecclesiastes (OT125): This class will focus on the message and theology of Ecclesiastes. We will examine interpretive issues in the book, along with the book's background and literary features as well as its contribution to biblical theology in the context of the Old Testament wisdom books.

Created to Worship (PT533): A study of the biblical material on worship in order to understand worship on this side of the Cross. These truths will be applied to the practical aspects of cultivating a worshipping church and designing God-centered worship services.

Hebrews (NT217): This course is a brief exposition of the letter to the Hebrews, focusing on the purpose and argument of the book. The goal is that the students will be familiar with how the letter emphasizes the superiority of our Lord Jesus and the implications of that truth for the believer, both for their spiritual growth as followers of Christ and so that they might be better equipped to make disciples of others.
