Course Descriptions

Designed to Do More (PT535): In this class, we will explore the biblical foundations and practical strategies for living a productive life that honors God. Students will learn to steward their time, energy, and resources effectively to get more done in their areas of responsibility. Through Scripture and actionable tools, we'll discover how to overcome distractions and cultivate habits that lead to meaningful, God-glorifying work.

Becoming Equipped for Evangelism (PT536): This class aims to equip you to communicate the gospel effectively with the lost people around you. Topics will include understanding the gospel clearly, motivations to evangelize, how to pursue the lost and build redemptive relationships, using the Bible in evangelism, and the role of the local church in evangelism. Emphasis will be given to practical application.

Survey of the OT Prophets (OT104): A study of the Old Testament prophetic literature, including consideration of the ancient Near Eastern historical and cultural context. Emphasis is given to the theme and structure of each prophetic book as well as key theological issues. The student is made aware of the continuing relevance of the prophetic books for walking in obedience to Christ today.

History of the Reformation (CH413): A study of the Reformation period from the time of Martin Luther through the beginnings of the Puritan Movement in England. This course will focus on key figures and the contributions these figures made to Christian theology. Roman Catholic responses to the Reformation will also be discussed.
