Course Descriptions

1 and 2 Thessalonians (NT215): This course is an exposition of 1 and 2 Thessalonians, focusing on the books' purpose and argument. Special attention will be given to the debated theological questions surrounding Paul's two letters. The goal is for students to be familiar with the messages of these books so that they not only apply them to their own lives but also share them with others.

Poetic Books (OT551): This course will be a study of the message of Job through Song of Songs. Emphasis will be given to both the poets' and sages' historical setting, their literary forms, and their contribution to biblical theology. The goal is for the student to be familiar with the poetic writings and better equipped to apply their message today.

Becoming a Healthy Church Member (PT501): Healthy Christians are healthy church members. This course aims to help believers grow as active participants in their local churches, so that the body is built up as God's love is increasingly displayed and enjoyed there. To accomplish this, we will address twelve areas of church life and how to be best involved in each.

History of Christianity in America (CH401): This course is a study of the progress and expansion of Christian movements in America, beginning with British colonization (1607) through the early twentieth century. Special attention will be given to the New England Puritans.
